Our Nursery children are enjoying a bee theme this week. They have been making their own bee art work, exploring hexagon shapes in Maths and tasting honey. Today there are lots of buzzy bees around nursery, all dressed up and having fun!

Reception caterpillars have made their chrysalises now which is very exciting as the children watch for their next changes. Children have also been practising their subtraction and odds and evens.

Year 1 children went on their school trip to Tatton Park. A great time was had by all – a photo from this trip is at the top of the page – They have also written recounts about their trip.

Year 2 pupils finished their SAT's tests this week. Well done everyone on all of your hard work. They have also been writing stories! Year 3 pupils have been gathering information about the exciting birds and animals that live in the rainforest.
