Dear Parents and Carers,

This may well have been our shortest half term of the year but it has been packed 'full to bursting' with the usual excitement in learning but we have also been busy making plans for next half term.

In Nursery, children have been reading 'The Snail and the Whale'. They have also been drawing and making labels too.

In Reception, some of the butterflies have hatched from their cocoons Mrs Medford is also taking one home that has still to hatch, plus one with a broken wing to see how she can help it. The children have also been planting seeds this week and looking at growing and planting.

Year 1 children have been planting broad beans and talking about conditions for growth. Ask your child what plants need to grow and how to best look after them.
