Historical Chronology

- Sequence several objects/events in chronological order. (recent history).
- Uses words and phrases: old, new, young, days, months, long time ago
- Remembers parts of stories and memories about the past.
- Can they explain how they have changed since they were born?

 Tell the difference between past and present in own and other people's lives. Do they understand we have a queen who rules us and that Britain has had a king or queen for many years?
