Play and Perform	Create and Compose
<p>Use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and chanting rhymes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Speak chants and rhymes• Singing questions• Class/assembly singing• Call and response songs with a range of doh-soh (eg twinkle twinkle – 5 notes)• Rhythm work ‘Cat Monkey Rest’• Sol-fa work (not compulsory) Soh me lah	<p>Play tuned and un-tuned instruments musically.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Un-tuned percussion• Tuned percussion• Walk, move or clap a steady beat• Perform repeating rhythm patterns• Select your own instruments and create a short piece that reflects a certain mood and/or event• Improvise vocal chants• Create musical sound effects and short sequences of sounds• Invent and recall rhythm patterns <p>Notation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Graphic notation (NB sound before symbol)• Follow pictures and symbols to guide singing and playing
Respond and Review	Listening and applying knowledge and understanding
<p>Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high quality live and recorded music.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognise percussion• Male voice• Female voice• Live music• Listen to sounds in the local environment	<p>Experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using inter-related dimensions of music.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Select your own instruments and create a short piece that reflects a certain mood and/or event• Dynamics=Loud/soft• Tempo= fast/slow• Pitch= high/low• Duration= long/short



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
