Pupils who will start in Nursery and Reception classes at Warren Wood will have the same term dates as the rest of the school. However, there will be flexible induction dates that we will discuss directly with parents and carers as their child is welcomed to school. These will be outlined in further communications contained within your child's induction pack.

All parents are asked to be aware of local and national guidelines surrounding holidays which cannot be authorised during term time. School takes a very proactive approach to attendance and punctuality and will issue letters to remind you if your child's attendance falls below nationally acceptable guidelines. Removing your child for family holidays during term time could result in fines being issued by the local authority. Please ask at the school office for a copy of the government guidance on this. During May, Year 2 and Year 6 pupils have traditionally taken statutory assessment tests. Whilst Year 2 tests are suggested as optional from next year (at the time of writing – this may be subject to change), Year 6 tests are statutory. We respectfully ask that it is essential that children are in school during these periods. Pupils in Year 1 undertake Phonics screening during June along with Y4 pupils taking their statutory Times Tables tests too. It is also essential that pupils do not miss school at all, where possible.
