Dear Parents and Carers

This week, your children have told me some of the wonderful things that they have learned or felt at school. I have told them that I will share some of these on the newsletter and that you will ask them more about it – just to check they can remember all the fun we have had!

Throughout school, we commemorated Remembrance Day. A picture of some beautiful artwork by our Nursery pupils is displayed at the top of this page.

In Reception, the children have been enjoying some physical development activities outdoors – using the bikes and playing hockey have been firm favourites!

Year 1 children have been learning about the human body and making skeletons. They have also been enjoying learning about Divali and making Diva lamps.

Year 2 children have enjoyed colour mixing in their artwork. They have also been very keenly learning about money – always a tricky one for children, especially when we are moving towards a cashless society!

Year 3 taught me everything I needed to know (and more!) about soil this week – ask your child how many layers of soil there are and what they are called - You may be surprised by the answer!

In Y4, pupils continue to learn about sound, how it travels and the changes to sound due to the vibrations. They have also learned about Greek gods and goddesses and written autumn poems using metaphors and similes – ask them to give you an example!

Our upper junior pupils were excited to visit Marple Hall High school this week to see their production of 'We Will Rock You'. It is always an exciting opportunity for our pupils to experience high schools before they make the leap from primary to secondary school.
